SUMMARY:

Robert Chabot was a local businessman and strong supporter of the Emery Village BIA. He ran his business (Centennial Sweeping) in the Emery Village area since 1957. Robert Chabot, along with his daughter Lorraine Chabot-Vecera spearheaded the founding of the Emery Village BIA in 2003. Robert Chabot was an active member of the BIA who gladly participated and volunteered his time to Emery Village BIA events, most notably, making his traditional appearance as Santa Claus at the Annual Emery Village BIA Lighting Ceremony.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. That the Etobicoke York Community Council endorse the ceremonial designation of Toryork Drive, between Weston Road and Milvan Drive, as "Rue Bob Chabot", with special street name signs. All costs associated with this designation and related signage to be borne by the Emery Village BIA.
2. In the event that the above Recommendation 1 fails, the Etobicoke York Community Council request the Director, Community Planning, Etobicoke York District to report to the Community Council in 2011, on the feasibility of identifying a proposed street on the draft Plan of Subdivision at 3035 Weston Road.
