Designation of Significant Event for 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Lakeshore Mardi Gras Festival – August 13, 14 & 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010 – Ward 6, Etobicoke – Lakeshore

## Summary:

The 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Lakeshore Mardi Gras Festival is a wonderful event that promotes and encourages the Etobicoke – lakeshore community and residents of Toronto to come out and meet their neighbours while participating in the many activities.
