SUMMARY

Youth are an important part of the volunteer team within Long-Term Care Homes and Services. At present, one in three of our active volunteers are under the age of 18 years.

Community involvement is a high school requirement and volunteering with Toronto Long-Term Care Homes and Services is a rewarding way for students to earn community service hours. We encourage young people to give their time and talents and will hold the third annual Volunteer Youth Summit on Friday, February 12, 2010.

The third annual Volunteer Youth Summit will be an opportunity for youth volunteers to get together with their peers, to share ideas and to develop program and activity ideas specific to them and their service to residents in the homes.

Friday, February 12th is a professional development day for both the Toronto District School Board and the Toronto Catholic District School Board; this year's summit will take place at City Hall.

Representatives from all ten homes are being encouraged to attend and participate. We expect to have thirty attendees.

There are sufficient funds in the General Donations Account, \$13,311.86, to cover this request.

The Volunteer Youth Summit supports the direct divisional work underway and complements the Mayor's initiatives to expand opportunities for Toronto's youth.
