tap into your fun side.

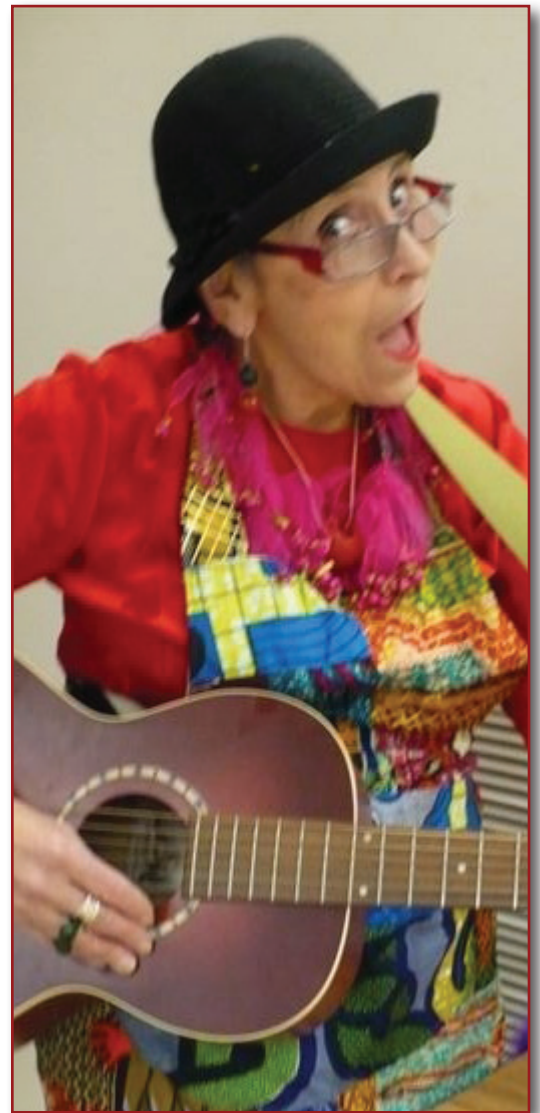
The course is open to current
