## Re: Report on the Review of Metrolinx Noise and Vibration Assessments

At the June 8, 9 meeting City Council adopted a motion from the Parks & Environment Committee requesting the Medical Officer of Health and the Director of the Toronto Environment Office to review the Metrolinx noise and vibration study to ensure the acoustical accuracy of the study in relation to the new MP40 diesel trains or any other proposed diesel trains and to report back on any data that may be missing for every aspect of the Corridor.

The August meeting of the Parks & Environment Committee has been cancelled and deferring the report to the new term would mean that the recommendations would not be timely in relation to Metrolinx' process. I am requesting that it be placed on the agenda for the August 20 meeting of the Board of Health.
