**Activities at Certain Business Establishments in the Etobicoke York District**

Dear Councillor Nunziata:

At the last meeting on October 13, 2009, city legal provided definition to the Community Council of their definition of illicit activity to pertain to illicit sexual activity. Concerns were also raised by Council members regarding the Ontario Court of Appeal decision to review legal questions which could possible redefine prostitution laws and might imply to permit some business establishments in your district to lawfully conduct sex services.

I would highly recommend that the Community Council move to request Councillor Moscoe's Licensing & Standards Committee place a matter on their agenda for their January 2010 meeting to provide a better definition of prohibited activity that better classifies respective city by-laws what west end politicians' expectations are to denote prohibited activity in these places.

I provide the following legal definition that clearly defines and implies that, if adopted, these places would not be given legal non-conforming status as a result of upcoming court decisions.

**RECOMMENDED DEFINITION OF PROHIBITED ACTIVITY IN BODY-RUB PARLOURS AND HOLISTIC CENTRES:**

*"Specified Sexual Activities" means one or more of the following:  
actual or simulated sexual intercourse, masturbation, urination, defecation, ejaculation, sodomy, including bestiality, anal intercourse, oral sexual intercourse, physical stimulation of the genital organs and flagellation, bondage or torture in the context of a sexual relationship or activity.*
