## Status Update on Toronto Computer Leasing Inquiry and Toronto External Contracts Inquiry - by Councillor Bussin, seconded by Councillor Walker

## Recommendations

Councillor Bussin, seconded by Councillor Walker, recommends that:

1. City Council request the Commissioner of the Ontario Provincial Police to provide City Council with a report on his investigation into Madame Justice Bellamy's report and its status.

## Summary

Madame Justice Denise Bellamy released her taxpayer funded \$17.2 million report on the Toronto Computer Leasing Inquiry and the Toronto External Contracts Inquiry on September 12, 2005. City Council considered the report at its meeting held on September 28, 29 and 30, 2005 as Notice of Motion J (7).

Council at that meeting referred the report of Madame Justice Bellamy to the Toronto Police Service for forwarding to another Police Service for investigation. Council's support at this time for Councillor Sandra Bussin's motion regarding the need for an independent police investigation was prompted, in part, by the statement of Madame Justice Bellamy on page 376 of her report that stated: "Whether they acted in concert or independently, the consistency of their lies gives credence to the theory that Dash Domi made, and Tom Jakobek accepted, an improper payment of \$25,000."

This matter was referred to the Ontario Provincial Police. There has been no further information or report on the status or outcome of the investigation.
