Recommendations

Summary

The Vancouver 2010 Paralympic Torch Relay Toronto Community Celebration event organizers are requesting permission to use an open flame on March 5, 2010 on Nathan Phillips Square. To meet the deadlines as set out by VANOC, this permission is required as part of the plan submission by January 31, 2010.

Municipal Code Chapter 237 “Nathan Phillips Square” prohibits the use of open flame and special effects pyrotechnics on “Nathan Phillips Square” without the approval of Council.
