Request to Amend the 2010 Capital Budget for Cecil Street Park Playground Enhancements - by Councillor Vaughan, seconded by Councillor Carroll

Recommendations

Councillor Vaughan, seconded by Councillor Carroll, recommends the following:

1. City Council amend the City Council-approved Parks, Forestry and Recreation 2010 Capital Budget to increase the Recreational Infrastructure Canada (RInC) Project, Cecil Street Park Playground Enhancements (Ward 20), by \$36,000 for a total of \$136,000, funded from the new cash in lieu of parkland dedication for alternative parkland dedication for Ward 20 from 371, 393-377 and 379 King Street West, Account/internal order number XR2213-3700197 to supplement the current funding in order to award the project tender to the lowest bidder.

Summary

Authority is being sought to amend the 2010 Parks, Forestry and Recreation Capital Budget, approved by Council, to increase the Recreational Infrastructure Canada (RInC) Project, Cecil Street Park Playground Enhancements, by \$36,000 to a total of \$136,000 with funding from the new cash in lieu of parkland dedication for alternative parkland dedication for Ward 20 from 371, 393-377 and 379 King Street West. These additional funds are required to supplement existing City Council-approved RInC funding for the capital project in order to award the project tender to the lowest bidder.

At its meeting on May 25, 2010, (Item TE34.41), Toronto East York Community Council approved a motion to rename Cecil Street Park to Julius Deutsch Park.
