Summary

Renowned city builder George Herczeg passed away on July 10, 1010. Mr. Herczeg played a significant role in establishing Toronto as a “city of neighbourhoods” that embraces its architectural heritage. In recognition of his achievements, the Herczeg family has expressed interested in providing support for the Toronto Urban Design Awards in his memory I have discussed the family’s expression of interest with the Chief Planner who suggested that this request be forwarded to his office for review and appropriate action.
