Recommendations

Summary

Subsequent to entering into the existing Infrastructure Stimulus Fund (ISF) agreement with the Federal government, a number of approved projects were cancelled because they could not be completed by March 31, 2011 as required under the terms of the agreement. This resulted in uncommitted Federal funding that is available for new eligible infrastructure project.

To maximize the use of the ISF, the City submitted an application for the TCHC Moss Park Tower Renewal Project, which has been approved in principle by the Federal government. The project cost of \$6 million will be funded \$2 million by the Federal Government, and the balance of \$4 million will be fully funded by TCHC. There will be no incremental impact on the City's 2010 – 2019 Capital Budget and Plan.
