

Removal of On Street Parking Space for Persons with Disabilities: Bowie Avenue

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that the Community Council has delegated authority to make a final decision, provided that it is not amended so that it varies with City policy or by-laws.

To obtain approval to remove the existing on street disabled persons parking space adjacent to 133 Bowie Avenue.

The removal of the on street disabled parking space will not result in any negative impact, as the parking space is no longer being used.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services Division recommends that North York Community Council

1. Approve the removal of the existing on street parking space for persons with disabilities on the south side of Bowie Avenue, between a point 21.2 metres west of Chamberlain Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further west thereof.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

All costs associated with the removal of the on street disabled persons parking space adjacent to 133 Bowie Avenue are included within the Transportation Services Division 2010 Operating Budget estimate.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

The Transportation Services Division, North York District, was requested by a resident on Bowie Avenue, to remove the on street disabled persons parking space adjacent to 133 Bowie Avenue.

COMMENTS

Bowie Avenue is a local residential roadway with a pavement width of approximately 8.5 metres and has municipal sidewalks on both sides of the roadway. Currently, alternate side on street permit parking exists on Bowie Avenue from 12:00 midnight to 6:00 a.m. between April 1 and December 1. Parking is prohibited at anytime on the south side of Bowie Avenue, between December 1 and April 1.

It has been brought to our attention that the disabled persons parking space which is provided in front of 133 Bowie Avenue is no longer required. The individual for whom the space was initially created has moved and the new owner does not require the parking space. Our observations have confirmed that the on street disabled persons parking space is no longer being used.

As such, this division recommends that the on street disabled persons parking space on Bowie Avenue be removed.
