

## **Installation of an On Street Parking Space for Persons with Disabilities: Donlea Drive**

### **SUMMARY**

---

This staff report is about a matter that the Community Council has delegated authority to make a final decision, provided that it is not amended so that it varies with City policy or by-laws.

To obtain approval to install an on-street disabled persons parking space adjacent to 43 Donlea Drive.

The installation of the disabled persons parking space will address the needs of the residents of 43 Donlea Drive, while only reducing the available on-street parking by one space.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

---

Transportation Services recommends that North York Community Council:

1. Approve the installation of one on street parking space for persons with disabilities on the south side of Donlea Drive, between a point 82.0 metres east of Hanna Road and a point 5.5 metres east thereof.

### **FINANCIAL IMPACT**

All costs associated with the installation of a disabled persons parking space adjacent to 43 Donlea Drive are included in the Transportation Services Division's 2010 Operating Budget estimate.

## **ISSUE BACKGROUND**

The Transportation Services Division received a request from a resident of 43 Donlea Drive to investigate the feasibility of installing an on-street disabled persons parking space adjacent to their residence.

## **COMMENTS**

Donlea Drive between Hannah Road and Rumsey Road is a local road with a pavement width of approximately 8.5 metres with sidewalks on both sides.

Currently, parking is permitted for maximum periods of three hours on both sides of Donlea Drive at this location.

The applicant is a holder of a valid disabled persons parking permit issued by the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario.

The requested location of the designated parking space will be on the south side of the roadway entirely in front of the home of the resident requesting the creation of the designated parking space for persons with disabilities. The creation of this designated parking space will not result in the deprivation of more than one on-street parking space and will not have a negative impact on the availability of on-street parking for residents of Donlea Drive.

In view of the above, this division supports the recommendation to install a designated parking space for the disabled at 43 Donlea Drive.

Councillor John Parker supports the recommendations of this staff report.
