

Extension of Overnight On-Street Permit Parking Hours Fairlawn Avenue

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is requesting approval from North York Community Council to extend overnight on-street permit parking hours on Fairlawn Avenue, between Elm Road and a point 134.5 metres further west, from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., 7 days a week to 12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services Division recommends that North York Community Council:

1. Extend the overnight on-street permit parking hours of operation on Fairlawn Avenue, between Elm Road and a point 134.5 metres further west, from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., 7 days a week to 12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

Financial Impact

All costs associated with the installation of the revised permit parking signage are included within the Transportation Services Division's 2010 Operating Budget estimates.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

A request was received from Councillor Karen Stintz, on behalf of area residents, for the extension of overnight on-street permit parking hours on Fairlawn Avenue, between Elm Road and a point 134.5 metres further west, from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., 7 days a week to 12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

COMMENTS

Fairlawn Avenue, between Elm Road and a point 134.5 metres further west, is a local street operating in a two-way east/westbound direction, on a pavement width of 8.5 metres. No TTC service operates on Fairlawn Avenue. Parking is allowed for a maximum period of 3 hours on both sides of the street with overnight on-street permit parking in effect from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

Area residents requested the extension of overnight on-street permit parking hours on Fairlawn Avenue, between Elm Road and a point 137.5 metres further west to alleviate the problem of long term parking.
