The Toronto Cycling Advisory Committee:


- 1. Background:

The Toronto Cycling Advisory Committee on January 18, 2010 had before it an e-mail letter (January 18, 2010) from Margaret Hastings-James, Member, Toronto Cycling Advisory Committee, tendering her resignation from the Toronto Cycling Advisory Committee.

City Council on September 26 and 27, 2007 considered Planning and Growth Management Committee Item 8.11 headed "Appointments to the Toronto Cycling Advisory Committee" and adopted the following motions:

1. City Council approve the appointment of the eight candidates listed on the attached Confidential List for membership to the Toronto Cycling Advisory Committee, for a term of office expiring on November 30, 2010, or until their successors are appointed.
2. City Council approve the appointment of the eight alternate candidates listed on the attached Confidential List, in the sequential order presented, in order to fill a mid-term vacancy, if the need arises.
