### **ISSUE BACKGROUND**

The new Zoning By-law Project is about creating a single zoning by-law for the City. The first draft of the new zoning by-law was released to the public in May 2009 via the City's website. Open houses have been held and several Ward specific meetings were attended by staff to hear and address concerns with the proposed draft zoning by-law. A report on

the results of the consultation was before the Committee at its meeting held on November 4, 2009. A further report addressing the public comments received by the Committee was prepared for the February 11, 2010 meeting.
