Subject: Draft Policies and Terms of Reference for Designating Heritage Conservation Districts in Toronto

Recommendations:

The Toronto Preservation Board recommended to the Planning and Growth Management Committee that:

- 1. Council direct staff to report back to Toronto City Council with a completed Policies and Terms of Reference and for Designating HCDs in Toronto after scheduling community consultations for interested parties, and the public at large, to obtain their comments and feedback regarding the draft document; and**
- 2. City Council request the Chief Planner and Executive Director, City Planning to expand the notification guidelines to include adjacent property owners, neighbouring resident groups and Local Business Improvement Associations.**
