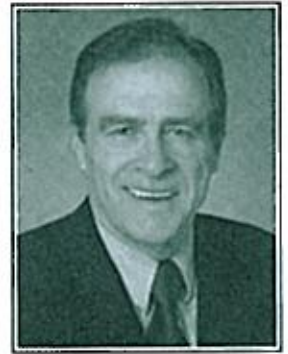

SUBJECT: Electronic Policing Pilot Project – Pharmacy Avenue

Speeding is a problem in every community across the city. Nowhere is this more evident than on Pharmacy Avenue south of Finch. That short stretch of road has 3 schools on it. A primary school, senior school and a collegiate. With a total of 1,800 students.

There have been several accidents in the past number of years, resulting in a call for enhanced policing on that stretch of road. Regrettably, the city cannot afford the expense of a 24 hour police presence there or anywhere else.

However, there is a solution. Technology has given us the ability to police our roads 24/7 through electronic means.

A number of city's in Canada already do this, as do many other in the United States.

I'm requesting the Works Committee to ask the Provincial Government for permission to introduce a pilot electronic policing project on the section of Pharmacy Avenue involving the three schools.
