SUMMARY

This Staff report is about a matter for which the Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

The purpose of this report is to consider a request by the owner(s) of 1 Fallingbrook Drive to be exempted from Chapter 447-Fences section (2) of the Toronto Municipal Code. This section states that the maximum height of a fence in the front yard on a residential property is 1.2 metres.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Municipal Licensing and Standards, Scarborough District, recommends that Scarborough Community Council:

1. Refuse the proposed front yard 1.72 metre high stone/iron fence located on private property at 1 Fallingbrook Drive.

Financial Impact

There is no financial implication.

DECISION HISTORY

[The City of Toronto Council enacted the amalgamated Fence By-law on July 6, 2000 to prescribe the height and description of fences on private property and to require owners of privately owned outdoor swimming pools to erect and maintain fences and gates around swimming pools. This by-law and the amendments are now found in Chapter 447 of the Toronto Municipal Code.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

The owner of 1 Fallingbrook Drive has submitted an application for a Fence Exemption under Chapter 447 and received by Municipal Licensing and Standards on October 26, 2009, for a proposed stone/iron fence located in the front yard. The height of the fence is 1.72 metres high.
