Demolition Dust Control Plan

Quantum Murray LP (QMLP) will be implementing the following measures to control dust during the demolition of the 12 Hallbank Terrace when and where necessary in accordance with the City of Toronto, Toronto Public Health Approved Recommendations:

- Wet the demolition area such as the part of the structure being demolished in order to mitigate dust in order to reduce the risk of worker exposure as well as the possibility of dusts impacting the neighboring community.
- Wet, daily or more frequently if required, all soft and hard surfaces and any excavation face on the site.
- Wash down pavement and sidewalks affected by the demolition program as required.
- Provide workers with proper personal protective equipment when and where necessary.
- Designate truck loading points, such as paved areas, to avoid trucks tracking demolition debris off site and clean truck loading points as required.
- Clean trucks leaving the site of any loose demolition debris or dust including sweeping of exteriors and tailgates by designated labour.
- Tarp trucks leaving the site carrying demolition debris.
