As you are aware of the situation at 3354 Kingston Road, the unit on said property has been deemed structurally unsound by Belanger Engineering Consulting Engineers. The application for a demolition permit was previously denied by the Building Department due to the standing by-law in Toronto. The Enforcement Division has placed additional pressure to have this dwelling demolished. An order has been issued to the previous developers to have the structure removed. This cannot be fulfilled legally unless a building permit can be issued.

Included in this package is the engineer's report, the pervious application and supporting documentation. Esquire Homes/ Mainbram Scarborough Developments inc. has all intentions of developing the property, but are currently several months away from being able to complete all the requirements for building permit issuance.

The concern is the structural state of the building and a need to provide a safe neighborhood for all residences. Esquire Homes/ Mainbram Scarborough Developments inc. would like to commence demolition immediately to ensure that public safety is maintained. Please have this concern brought to council for review and hopefully provide an exemption to the by-law so that the demolition may commence.
