SUMMARY

This report responds to a need to amend the parking regulation by-laws for consistency with the posted signage on the east side of Warden Avenue from Eglinton Avenue East to Comstock Road

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services recommends that:

- City Council rescind the parking regulation, as identified in Appendix 1 of the report dated July 20, 2010, entitled "Proposed Parking Prohibition Amendments for the East Side of Warden Avenue from Eglinton Avenue East to Comstock Road, By-Law Housekeeping" from the Director, Transportation Services, Scarborough District.
- 2. City Council enact the parking regulation, as identified in Appendix 2 of the report dated July 20, 2010, entitled "Proposed Parking Prohibition Amendments for the East Side of Warden Avenue from Eglinton Avenue East to Comstock Road, By-Law Housekeeping" from the Director, Transportation Services, Scarborough District.
- 3. City Council pass or amend the appropriate by-law(s) accordingly.

Financial Impact

There is no financial impact at this time.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

Further to a parking regulation review, Transportation Services staff has identified a need to amend the parking regulation by-laws to maintain congruency with the posted signage on the East Side of Warden Avenue from Eglinton Avenue East to Comstock Road.

COMMENTS

Several characteristics describing the subject portion of Warden Avenue include:

- The land use on this section of Warden Avenue is commercial, industrial and retail
- Warden Avenue is a five-lane north-south major arterial roadway with a posted speed limit of 60 kilometres per hour and a traffic volume of approximately 30,000 vehicles per day.
- The by-law amendment will allow for proper enforcement of parking regulations on the East Side of Warden Avenue from Eglinton Avenue East and Comstock Road.

It is recommended that Transportation Services rescind the inactive parking regulations and enact a "No Parking Anytime" regulation on the east side of Warden Avenue, from Eglinton Avenue East to Comstock Road.

This will allow for proper enforcement of these regulations and enhance safety for pedestrians and motorists.
