Introduce One Hour Maximum Parking Regulation – Bartlett Avenue

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is requesting approval to introduce a one-hour maximum parking regulation from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on the east side Bartlett Avenue, from Dupont Street to a point 44.1 metres further north.

The one-hour regulation combined with sufficient enforcement should result in more parking opportunities for residents and customers of local businesses.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services recommends that Toronto and East York Community Council:

1. Approve the introduction of one-hour maximum parking regulation from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on the east side of Bartlett Avenue, from Dupont Street to a point 44.1 metres further north.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

Councillor Adam Giambrone, on behalf of area residents, has requested Transportation Services to investigate introducing a maximum one-hour parking regulation from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on the east side of Bartlett Avenue, between Dupont Street and the C.P.R. railway tracks.

COMMENTS

Bartlett Avenue is a local roadway operating two-way with a pavement width of 7.4 metres and a posted speed limit of 40 km/h. There is no TTC service on Bartlett Avenue.

Parking is currently allowed for a maximum period of 3 hours at all times on the east side of Bartlett Avenue, and prohibited at all times on the west side from Dupont Street to C.P.R. railway tracks.

Introducing a one-hour maximum parking regulation will ensure that vehicles are not parked for excessive durations and provide more parking opportunities for residents and local businesses.
