## NOTICE OF MOTION

TEYCC: Re-Naming of Cecil Street Parkette to Julius Deutsch Park

## SUMMARY:

Julius Deutsch, a dedicated leader and well-respected champion of many progressive causes in our city died on February 5, 2010.

Leaving the memorial for Julius that was held at the Steelworkers Hall on Cecil Street, a small green spot on the street outside caught my eye and my imagination. Julius's spirit and commitment to social justice deserves to live on and be noted in a permanent way.

There is a park located at the corner of Cecil Street and Huron in Ward 20. It is a small strip park that runs along Cecil towards and across from the Steelworkers Hall. The park sits in front of a Toronto Hydro sub-station and is on the same street as an old synagogue, a Polish Combatants Hall, and homes that have provided offices for many of the this city's most progressive social movements.

This year the park will be re-built and new adult exercise equipment is being installed to create a green space in the neighbourhood where folks can work-out. It currently is called the Cecil Street Parkette. It's named for the street for no particular reason.

The composition of the site speaks to many facets of Julius' life, and a plaque that tells his story and his contribution to Toronto's story would be appropriate and a welcome part of the naming honour.
