I am writing in reference to your application submitted for Sidewalk/Boulevard Cafe privileges.


Boulevard cafes are governed by the criteria set out in Chapter 313-36 of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code. One of the provisions of the Code is that no part of the boulevard café shall be less than twenty-five (25) metres from a residential zone.

A review of the proposed location has determined taking into consideration the clearance requirement described above, that the application cannot be processed as applied, and therefore is refused.
