Reduction of Overnight On-Street Permit Parking – Lennox Street

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Area residents requested the reduction of the overnight on-street permit parking hours on Lennox Street, between Palmerston Boulevard and Markham Street, from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., 7 days a week, to 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

The reduction of the overnight on-street permit parking hours would allow non permit holders, such as visitors and tradespersons, to park during non-permit parking hours, without being subject to tagging by Parking Enforcement.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services recommends that Toronto and East York Community Council:

1. reduce the overnight on-street permit parking hours of operation on Lennox Street, between Palmerston Boulevard and Markham Street, from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., 7 days a week, to 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

A request was received from Deputy Mayor Joe Pantalone, on behalf of area residents, to reduce the overnight on-street permit parking hours on Lennox Street, between Palmerston Boulevard and Markham Street, from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., 7 days a week, to 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

COMMENTS

Lennox Street, between Palmerston Boulevard and Markham Street, is a local street operating in a two-way east/westbound direction, on a pavement width of 7.3 metres. There is no TTC service on Lennox Street. Parking is allowed on the south side of the street for a maximum period of 1 hour with overnight on-street permit parking in effect from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., 7 days a week.

A Public Notice was placed in a major newspaper on November 2, 2009, with an expiration date to raise objections of November 16, 2009. The Clerk has confirmed that no written objection was received by the expiration date.

Area residents requested the reduction of the on-street permit parking hours to alleviate the problem of tagging of their guests and tradespersons.
