#### **SUMMARY**

At its April 27, 2010 meeting, Toronto and East York Community Council requested the Director, Urban Forestry, Parks, Forestry and Recreation, to report with regard to the tree that was removed from City property at 76 Taunton Road.

The request was made while Toronto and East York Community Council had before it a report from the Manager, Right of Way Management, Transportation Services Toronto and East York District, item TE33.21, entitled, "Front Yard Parking Appeal – 76 Taunton Road."

This report will be submitted to the May 25, 2010 Toronto and East York Community Council meeting and considered at the same meeting as the report, "Front Yard Parking Appeal – 76 Taunton Road" from Transportation Services.

#### **DECISION HISTORY**

A report from the Manager, Right of Way Management, Transportation Services, regarding a front yard parking appeal was before Toronto and East York Community Council, at its meeting of April 27, 2010. The Toronto and East York Community Council deferred consideration of the report to its May 25, 2010 meeting and "requested the Director, Urban Forestry, Parks, Forestry and Recreation, to report with regard to the tree that was removed from City property at 76 Taunton Road."

#### COMMENTS

Originally there was a City-owned Norway maple tree located in the front yard of 76 Taunton Road. An inspection by Urban Forestry staff on May 1, 2008 revealed that the tree was in irreversible decline and no longer viable to maintain. The tree was scheduled for removal and subsequently removed on August 1, 2008. The final stage of tree removal involving removal of the stump took place on March 15, 2010. The property can now accommodate a replacement tree on City-owned property.
