Request for Report on Designating 204 Beech Avenue as a Heritage Property, May 25, 2010

At the May 25, 2010 meeting of the Toronto and East York Community Council, Community Council voted in favour of referring a letter from me to the Manager, Heritage Preservation Services with a request that staff expedite its report to the Toronto Preservation Board for its meeting on June 30, 2010, and Toronto and East York Community Council, on designating 204 Beech Avenue as a heritage property and including it on the Heritage Inventory.

Based on the issuance of a building permit to the owner of 204 Beech Avenue by the Building Department on Friday June 11, 2010, in accordance with the applicable laws of the Ontario Building Code, to remove the dormers, the turret and related interior alterations to the existing dwelling, reasons no longer exist to report 204 Beech Avenue to the Toronto Preservation Board on designating as a heritage property because of the removal of its most significant heritage features.

Therefore, I move that Community Council's request on May 25, 2010, that staff expedite its report to the Toronto Preservation Board for its meeting on June 30, 2010, and Toronto and East York Community Council, on designating 204 Beech Avenue as a heritage property and including it on the Heritage Inventory be rescinded by the Toronto East York Community Council at this meeting of June 22, 2010.
