Dear Mr. Dartsch:

In your letter of September 29, 2009, you requested that a poll be conducted to determine if there was sufficient neighbourhood support for speed humps on **Glenmount Park Road**, between Gerrard Street East and Corley Avenue.

Ballots were mailed out on October 19, 2009 with the last date for filing a response being November 17, 2009. The following is the poll result:

No Reply	113

I advise that speed humps cannot be approved pursuant to the City of Toronto Traffic Calming Policy, since 60% of the responses received were not in favour. Please note this poll cannot be conducted again until November 17, 2011, two (2) years after the closing date of the poll.
