

NOTICE OF MOTION**Heavy Truck Prohibition****Keystone Avenue, between Cedarvale Avenue and Morton Road****Moved by: Councillor Bussin** _____**Seconded by: Councillor** _____**SUMMARY:**

This motion is about a matter for which the Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

The residents of Keystone Avenue have requested that heavy trucks be prohibited due to safety concerns. Specifically, they are concerned with Toronto Hydro and Canada Post vehicles using Keystone Avenue to access the traffic control signals at the intersection of Patricia Drive and Danforth Avenue. The residents state that many school children cross at this intersection and these conflicts are unsafe. The trucks have direct access to Danforth Avenue via Morton Road which is unsignalized at Danforth Avenue.

It should be noted that all costs associated with the implementation of the heavy truck prohibition will be included within the Transportation Services Division's 2010 Operating Budget estimates.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That Toronto and East York Community Council:

1. Prohibit heavy trucks on Keystone Avenue, between Cedarvale Avenue and Morton Road.
