**Re: Request for extension of flanking patio hours on College Street (for specific locations between Bathurst Street and Delaware Avenue)**

As the local Councillor for the Ward, I am writing in support of local business owners along College Street during these unpredictable and challenging economic times. Specifically, I am requesting that the committee approve the extension of flanking patio hours to 12:00 midnight from Sunday to Thursday and to 1:00 am on Friday and Saturday, for specific locations along College Street (between Bathurst and Shaw Sts). Currently, the bylaw only allows flanking patios to be used until 11 pm.
