Re: Traffic and Parking Regulations on Brunel Court at Fort York Boulevard

I am respectfully requesting your permission to introduce this matter as new business. There are several new roads within the CityPlace neighbourhood which have been dedicated for public highway purposes. At this time, it is appropriate that Council approve signage and regulations for parking and traffic operations.

Recommendations

That Toronto and East York Community Council

- Approve the installation of "stop" signs for northbound traffic on Brunel Court at Fort York Boulevard and southbound traffic on Telegram Mews (private road) at Fort York Boulevard.
- 2. Prohibit parking at all times on the west side of Brunel Court from Fort York Boulevard to the south end of the street
- 3. Approve the installation of parking machines on the east side of Brunel Court from Fort York Boulevard to the south end of the street to operate from 8 am to 9 pm Monday to Saturday and from 1 pm to 9 pm Sunday at a rate of \$2 per hour.
