RE: Polling for speed humps on Wychwood between Vaughan and Maplewood

DATE: August 17, 2010

Recommendations

That the Toronto and East York Community Council direct:

- 1. Transportation Services to poll eligible householders on Wychwood Avenue, between Maplewood Avenue and Vaughan Road, to determine whether residents support the installation of speed humps, in accordance with the City of Toronto Traffic Calming Policy.
- 2. Subject to favourable results of the poll:
 - a. The City Solicitor prepare a by-law to alter the section of the roadway on Wychwood Avenue, between Maplewood Avenue and Vaughan Road, for traffic calming purposes, generally as shown on the attached copy of Drawing No. 421G-0114, dated July 2010.
 - b. Transportation Services take the necessary action to reduce the speed limit from forty kilometres per hour to thirty kilometres per hour on Wychwood Avenue, between Maplewood Avenue and Vaughan Road, when the speed humps are installed.
