## I would like to amend EY6.26 to include the following recommendations regarding Events of Municipal Significance for Liquor Licensing Purposes

- 1.For liquor licensing purposes, City Council advise the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario that it has no objection to the request for the issuance of a Special Occasion Permit for the Rotary Club to celebrate the culture, food, entertainment and music and to operate a beer garden at the annual Ribfest to be held in Centennial Park from June 30 to July 3, 2011.
- 2. For liquor licensing purposes, City Council advise the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario that it has no objection to the request for the issuance of a Special Occasion Permit for Fogarty's Bourbon Street at an event sponsored by the Long Branch Business Improvement Association to celebrate the culture, food, entertainment and music of the community to operate a beer garden at on June 24,2011.
- 3. For liquor licensing purposes, City Council advise the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario that it has no objection to the following requests for: a temporary liquor licence extension for the erection of a 20' x 40' canopy at the Mimico Cruising Club, 200 Humber Bay Road West, for the following events:
  - the Sailpast Event on Saturday, June 18, 2010, from 3:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.
  - for a temporary extension of their present liquor licence for its annual Lobster Dinner, 5:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. on Saturday June 4, 2011.
- 4. For liquor licensing purposes, City Council advise the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario that it has no objection to the following requests for: the issuance of a Special Events Permit for the Ontario Australian Rules Football League's Canada Day Football Carnival and Canada Cup Event to be held on July 1, 2010 at Colonel Samuel Smith Park, from 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., with a 10 x 30 foot food and beverage tent.
- 5. For liquor licensing purposes, City Council advise the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario that it has no objection to the following requests for the issuance of a Special Occasion Permit: The Annual Mardi Gras Festival to be held in Colonel Samuel Smith Park on August 12,13 and 14<sup>th</sup> including a with a food and beverage tent.
