Request to amend the Parks, Forestry and Recreation 2011 Capital Budget for Cedarvale Park Tennis Courts - by Councillor Joe Mihevc, seconded by Councillor John Parker

Recommendations

Councillor Joe Mihevc, seconded by Councillor John Parker, recommends that:

1. City Council grant approval to amend the 2011 Parks, Forestry and Recreation Capital Budget, approved by Council on February 23 and 24, 2011 to increase the capital project known as Cedarvale Park Tennis Courts – Fence/Reconstruct Tennis Pad surface in Ward 21 by \$39,000 to \$423,500 to be funded from a Section 37 agreement in the amount of \$39,000, generated from the development at 310, 320 Tweedsmuir Avenue in Ward 21. Funds have been received and are deposited to the Planning Act Reserve Fund account number XR3026-3700307.

Summary

Authority is being sought to amend the 2011 Parks, Forestry and Recreation Capital Budget, approved by Council on February 23 and 24, 2011 to increase the capital project known as Cedarvale Park Tennis Courts – Fence/Reconstruct Tennis Pad surface in Ward 21 by \$39,000 to \$423,500. The project increase is to be funded from a Section 37 agreement in the amount of \$39,000, generated from the development at 310, 320 Tweedsmuir Avenue in Ward 21. Funds have already been received and are deposited to the Planning Act Reserve Fund account number XR3026-3700307.

The additional funds are being used to install an acrylic surface to the tennis court. Other local tennis clubs interested in using Cedarvale Tennis Courts require that the surface be constructed of this material.

The contractor hired for the tennis court upgrade is currently on site; therefore, the amendment request is time-sensitive in order to ensure that the installation of the acrylic surface can be completed within the same timeframe as the original scope of work.
