BY-LAW No. -2011

To permanently close the public highway described as being the untravelled New Crescent between 697 and 699 Danforth Road on Plan 1776, save & except SC101937 and SC84473, and shown as Part 1 on Sketch No. PS-2003-100 (the “Highway”)

WHEREAS it is recommended that the public highway described as being the untravelled New Crescent on Plan 1776, save and except SC101937 and SC84473, and shown as Part 1 on Sketch No. PS-2003-100 (the “Highway”), be permanently closed as a public highway; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said highway was posted on the notices page of the City’s web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and the Scarborough Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter [or no one appeared to address the Scarborough Community Council at its meeting held on January 18, 2011];

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The public highway described as being the untravelled New Crescent between 697 and 699 Danforth Road on Plan 1776, save and except SC101937 and SC84473, and shown as Part 1 on Sketch No. PS-2003-100 (the “Highway”), is hereby permanently closed as a public highway.
