The Plan: Achieving 5 in 10

- Aggressive, Bold and Doable Plan.
- Build all 5 projects in 10 years.
- Proceed with three projects immediately.
 - Sheppard LRT
 - Eglinton LRT
 - York Viva
- Proceed with two projects in 2015 2020.
 - Scarborough RT
 - Finch LRT
- Proceed with phase 2 of projects as Investment Strategy funds come available.





Building the Big 5

Initial priority Big Move projects announced by Premier in April 2009

1.	York Viva Bus Rapid Transit (BRT)	\$ 1.4b
2.	Sheppard East Light Rail Transit (LRT)	\$.95b
3.	Finch Light Rail Transit (LRT)	\$ 1.2b
4.	Scarborough Rapid Transit (SRT)	\$ 1.4b
5.	Eglinton Crosstown LRT	\$ 4.6b

Toronto	\$ 8.15b
York	\$ 1.35b
Total	\$ 9.5 b

- Largest public transit investment in Canadian history
- Up to \$333 million from Federal government rest Provincial


February 2010 – Phasing plan for Toronto Projects

- In January 2010 TTC advises projects, if fully built, would cost \$10.5 billion, not \$8.15 billion in 2008 dollars – a \$2.4 billion gap
- Provincial contribution fixed at \$8.15 billion
- TTC and City not able to contribute funds
- Metrolinx and TTC worked together to develop options:
 - What could be paid for with \$8.15 billion provincial commitment
 - What program elements could be held to a second phase when additional funds would be available
- Consensus among Province, Metrolinx, City and TTC reached in February 2010





February 2010 – Proceed with all projects in a phased way



- York came in within original budget
- Phase 1 Toronto components from \$8.15 billion
- Phase 2 Toronto components from Metrolinx Investment Strategy





Phasing was considered. Not arbitrary

- Eglinton
 - Airport connection deferred by GTAA to 2020+
 - Will provide express bus transfer to Airport from LRT
 - LRT can be extended seamlessly
 - Air Rail Link will open 2015
- Scarborough RT to Malvern
 - Was Sheppard or Malvern
 - Significant cost of tunnel to Malvern
 - Can be extended seamlessly to Malvern
- Sheppard to Meadowvale
 - Must get to Conlins Yard
 - Can be extended seamless to Meadowvale
 - Or even the Toronto Zoo
- Finch East
 - Low Priority for City
- Finch Middle
 - Important but less urgent than Finch West
 - Finch West ties to Spadina Subway Extension and capacity
 - Easily extended to Yonge Street





March 2010 Ontario Budget

- Reaffirm commitment to all Big 5 projects
- Reaffirm budget of \$9.5 billion
- Province committed to escalation costs as funds spent from 2010 to 2020
- Restricted available cash flow for first 5 years by \$4 billion from \$7.7 billion to \$3.7 billion
- Asked Metrolinx to develop revised Plan with more extended timeframe





Achieving 5 in 10 Plan

Goal:

Complete the Big 5 Metrolinx *Big Move* Projects on budget in 10
years while reducing cash flow
requirements in first five years by
\$4 billion

- Aggressive, Bold and Doable
- Worked with York and TTC to confirm it can be done demanding but doable





Key principles of 5 in 10 plan

- Build all 5 projects
- Build as fast as possible given budget and cash flow constraints
- Complete all projects in 10 years instead of original 8 years
- Work with our partners York and Toronto – fair and equal treatment
- Construction planning and staging before we build to minimize disruption to communities






Key elements of 5 in 10 plan

- 1. Continue building York Viva BRT but completed over a longer period. Completed by 2020. Strong support from York.
- 2. Continue building Sheppard over original timeframe. Completed early 2014.
- 3. Move ahead immediately with Eglinton, beginning with tunnel. Completed by 2020.
- 4. Start Scarborough RT after Pan Am Games and Sheppard LRT. Completed 2020.
- 5. Start Finch in late 2015. Completed 2019.
- 6. Propose Investment Strategy to finance phase 2 not later than June 2013.





Compared to original timeline










VIVA - 2010 - 2015

- York VIVA BRT program dedicated bus lanes will open in operational segments as completed
- Construction started in 2009
- York currently in "cost confidence" stages to start construction on Davis drive in Fall 2010
- Highway 7, Davis Drive and Vaughan Metropolitan Centre complete and in-service during 2010-15
- 2010-15 investment:
 \$790M (escalated dollars)



VIVA - 2016 - 2020

- Second phase of construction planned to start in 2016
- Planned 2016-20 in-service dates include:
 - Yonge (Mulock to Davis) 2017
 - Yonge (Major Mac. to 19th) 2020
 - Highway 7 (west) 2020
 - Highway 7 (Unionville) 2020
- 2016-20 investment: \$965M (escalated dollars)








Sheppard East LRT – 2010-15

- Construction began at Agincourt GO station in December 2009
 - Additional major construction packages to proceed later this year
 - Conlins Yard a combined carhouse for the Sheppard East LRT and Scarborough RT to start construction late 2011
- Construction complete and in service by mid-2014
- 2010-15 investment: \$1,105M* (escalated dollars)
 - Includes cost of combined Sheppard / SRT Conlins Yard
- Phase 2 Sheppard-East from Conlins Yard to Meadowvale








Eglinton LRT – 2010-15

- Major activities planned during 2010-15 include:
 - Design and engineering for tunnel and underground stations
 - Property acquisition
 - Award tunnel boring machines contract June 2010
 - Start Tunnel Portal construction:
 - West January 2011
 - East January 2012
 - Start tunnelling from west January 2012
 - Start underground stations 2012
- Carhouse Preliminary Engineering
- 2010-15 investment: \$1,815M (escalated dollars)







Eglinton LRT – 2016-20

- Major activities planned during 2016-20 include:
 - Final property acquisition
 - Completion of station construction
 - Installation of track, signalling and communication systems
 - Completion of carhouse
 - Completion of eastern atgrade section to Kennedy Station
- Complete and in-service by 2020
- 2016-20 investment: \$4,250M (escalated dollars)







Scarborough RT – 2010-15

- Scarborough RT kept in service for Pan Am Games
- Major activities planned during 2010-15 include:
 - Construction and completion of Conlins Yard (combined Sheppard East LRT and Scarborough RT carhouse)
 - Preliminary design and engineering
 - Property acquisition
 - Pre-construction of Sheppard East LRT / Scarborough RT station
- **TTC** assurance Scarborough RT safe and sustainable to 2016
- 4 2010-15 investment: \$100M (escalated dollars), plus value of carhouse








Scarborough RT – 2016-20

- Major activities planned during 2016-20 include:
 - Construction start after completion of Pan Am games
 - Minimize out-of-service time
 - Final property acquisition
 - Vehicle delivery
- Construction completed and line in-service in 2020
- 2016-20 investment:
 \$2,365M (escalated dollars)








Finch LRT - 2010-15


- Major activities planned during 2010-15 include:
 - Completion of planning, engineering and design work to 30 percent
 - Property acquisition
 - Development of procurement documents for construction
- 2010-15 investment:
 \$70M (escalated dollars)





Finch LRT - 2016-20

- Major activities planned during 2016-20 include:
 - Final property acquisition
 - Line construction
 - Carhouse construction
 - Vehicle delivery
- Complete and in-service by: 2019
- 2016-20 investment: \$1,210M (escalated dollars)





Light Rail Vehicles

- Assuming successful negotiation, Metrolinx award of contract is planned for June 2010 to supply 182 LRVs for all 4 LRT lines:
 - Eglinton 76 cars
 - Finch 23 cars
 - Scarborough RT 48 cars
 - Sheppard 35 cars







Comments on cash flow

- Cash flows developed from TTC and York VIVA project estimates against revised schedules
- First five years reflects reduction in available cash flow
- Savings/Innovation reduction of \$180M is less than 5% of 5-year program and is achievable
- Cash flow in years 6-10 will continue to be refined. These are preliminary estimates at this time.
- **©** Cash flow is in escalated dollars

 - VIVA, Sheppard, Eglinton
- Begins \$7 billion of \$9.5 billion
- 2 more in 2015
 - Scarborough RT, Finch
- Reflects joint work
 - Metrolinx and VIVA
 - Metrolinx and TTC
- **From this point forward every week matters**
