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2012 CAPITAL BUDGET BRIEFING NOTE BIA Capital Cost-Share Requests – Funded/Unfunded Projects

Issue/Background:

- 47 of the 72 BIAs in the City submitted capital cost-share funding requests totaling \$7.770 million gross (\$3.885 million net) (see attached table) and 36 BIAs will receive funding in 2012.
- Projects recommended for capital cost-share program funding are prioritized based on the Capital Cost Share Guidelines approved by Council on July 22, 2003. However, a \$300,000 (gross) maximum funding was also applied to each BIA, as opposed to the \$600,000 (gross) maximum set out in the Capital Cost Share Guidelines.
- Those recommended for funding are considered "highest" priority in that they are either tied to other City road work contracts; continuation of a multi-phased project; or minor projects under \$35,000 (gross).
- The 2012 Recommended Capital Budget for Economic Development and Culture includes \$0.652 million for previously approved 2011 projects and \$2.812 million for new 2012 Projects, totalling \$3.464 million in 2012. Funding for 1 project totaling \$0.600 million gross (\$0.300 million net) is recommended for future year commitments in 2013.
- Of those 36 BIAs recommended for funding:
 - > 23 BIAs will receive the full amount requested for eligible projects.
 - 13 BIAs will receive less funding than requested for eligible (but lower priority) projects.
- 7 BIAs will receive no funding for eligible (but lower priority) projects totaling \$0.575 million gross (\$0.287 million net).
- 16 BIA requests were considered "not eligible for funding" or were not sufficiently advanced to be considered for 2012 funding.
- \$2.056 million gross (\$1.028 million net) in eligible (but lower priority) could not be accommodated within debt affordability targets.
- \$1.974 million gross (\$0.987 million net) in funding requests did not meet program criteria or are not sufficiently advanced and are therefore ineligible for consideration in the 2012 budget.

*Project management is that portion of the capital budget that is transferred to the operating budget to fund 3.5 FTE positions involved in the delivery of capital projects.

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
