- International design competition completed March 2007
- In June 2007, City Council approved winning design and awarded contract to winning design team led by Plant Architect Inc. and Shore Tilbe Irwin & Partners in Joint Venture
- Nathan Phillips Square Revitalization Public Advisory Group formed in 2006 to advise on NPS revitalization initiative and met until end of 2010
- Led by Facilities Management, Interdivisional Senior Staff Steering Committee established to advise on project implementation. The committee includes:
 - City Planning
 - Economic Development & Culture
 - Parks, Forestry & Recreation
 - Transportation Services
 - Toronto Parking Authority





SUSTAINABLE DESIGN FEATURES



- Installation of Podium Green Roof
- Harvest and reuse of rainwater
- Integrated storm water management
- Waste heat recovery for building heat
- Attention to on-site micro-climate
- Increased urban forest to cool the site
- Salvaged and recycled materials and sourcing locally
- Site lighting to control light pollution and preserve night sky
- Soil regeneration strategy
- Improved pedestrian environment
- LEED certification

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CONSTRUCTION IMPLEMENTATION

- Construction management firm (PCL Constructors Canada Inc.) retained to facilitate phased construction of project
- Phased construction started Spring 2010 for completion by end of 2013
- Phased construction to minimize disruption for NPS users
- Meeting construction schedule recognizing ongoing public activities at NPS
- Implementation of communications plan ongoing
