Contract Management Costs

In the comments section of the report dated April 27, 2012 "Solid Waste Curbside Collection, District 2 Contract Monitoring Plan", under Item 7 – Staffing for Contract Oversight, the budget is approximately \$1.2 million. This staffing component is made up of the following positions:

- 1 Manager Contract
- 1 General Supervisor of Operations
- 4 Supervisors
- 1 Research Analyst 2
- 1 Support Assistant C

Specific Performance Targets

The Request for Quotation No. 6603-11-3186 – Curbside Collection, District 2 contained a number of items that the Contractor must perform. The complete list is identified in the Attachment titled "Liquidated Damages List" and is now included in the final agreement between The City and the contractor, Green for Life.

The listing identifies the type of deficiency, the requirement and the associated liquidated damages applied per incident.

An example in the listing is the failure of the Contractor to have new equipment available at the start of the contract.

The damages associated with this are \$100.00 per day per vehicle until the new trucks are properly supplied.

Reporting to the Public Works and Infrastructure Committee

Staff will report back to the Public Works and Infrastructure Committee on the performance targets not being met. This information will be provided as part of staff's regular update.
