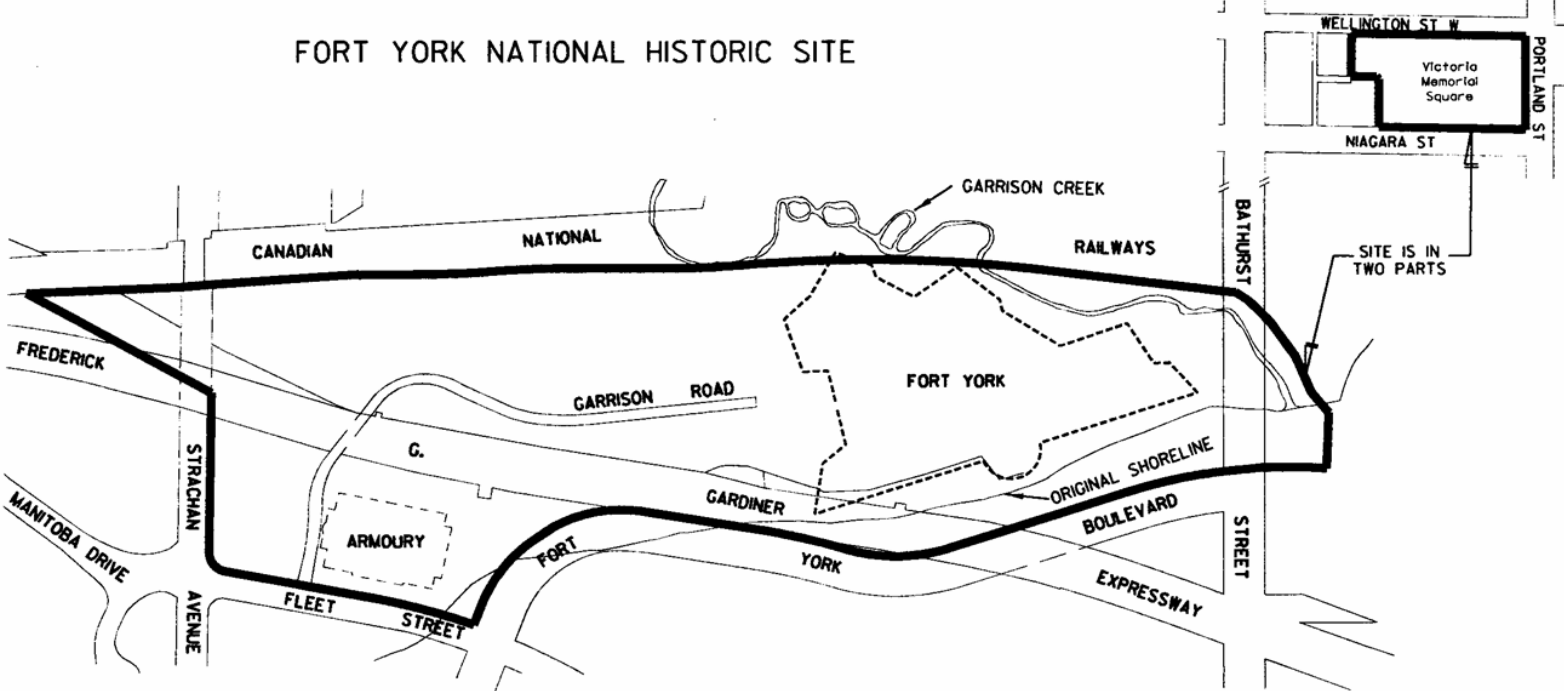

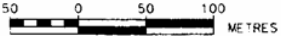

FORT YORK NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE

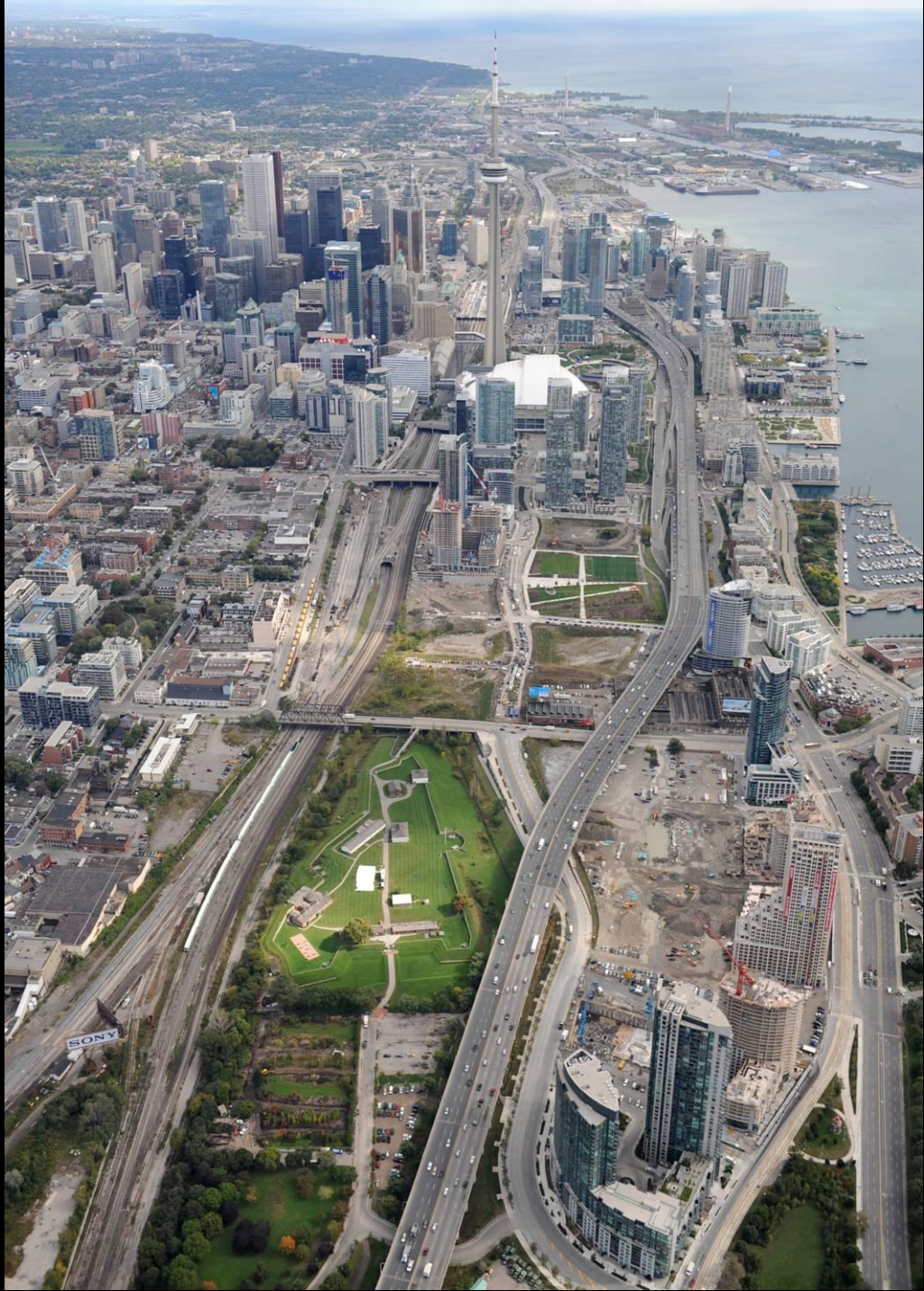

Fort York National Historic Site and Heritage Conservation District Boundaries

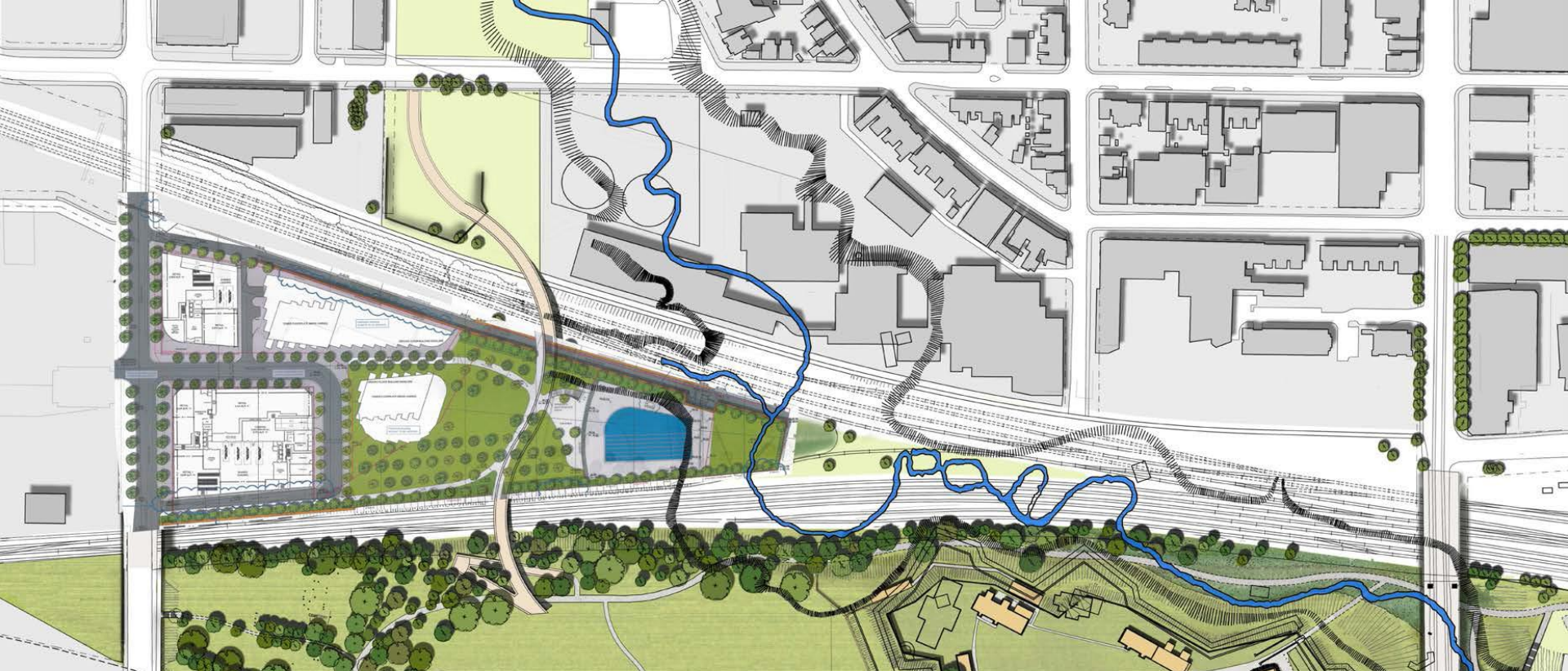

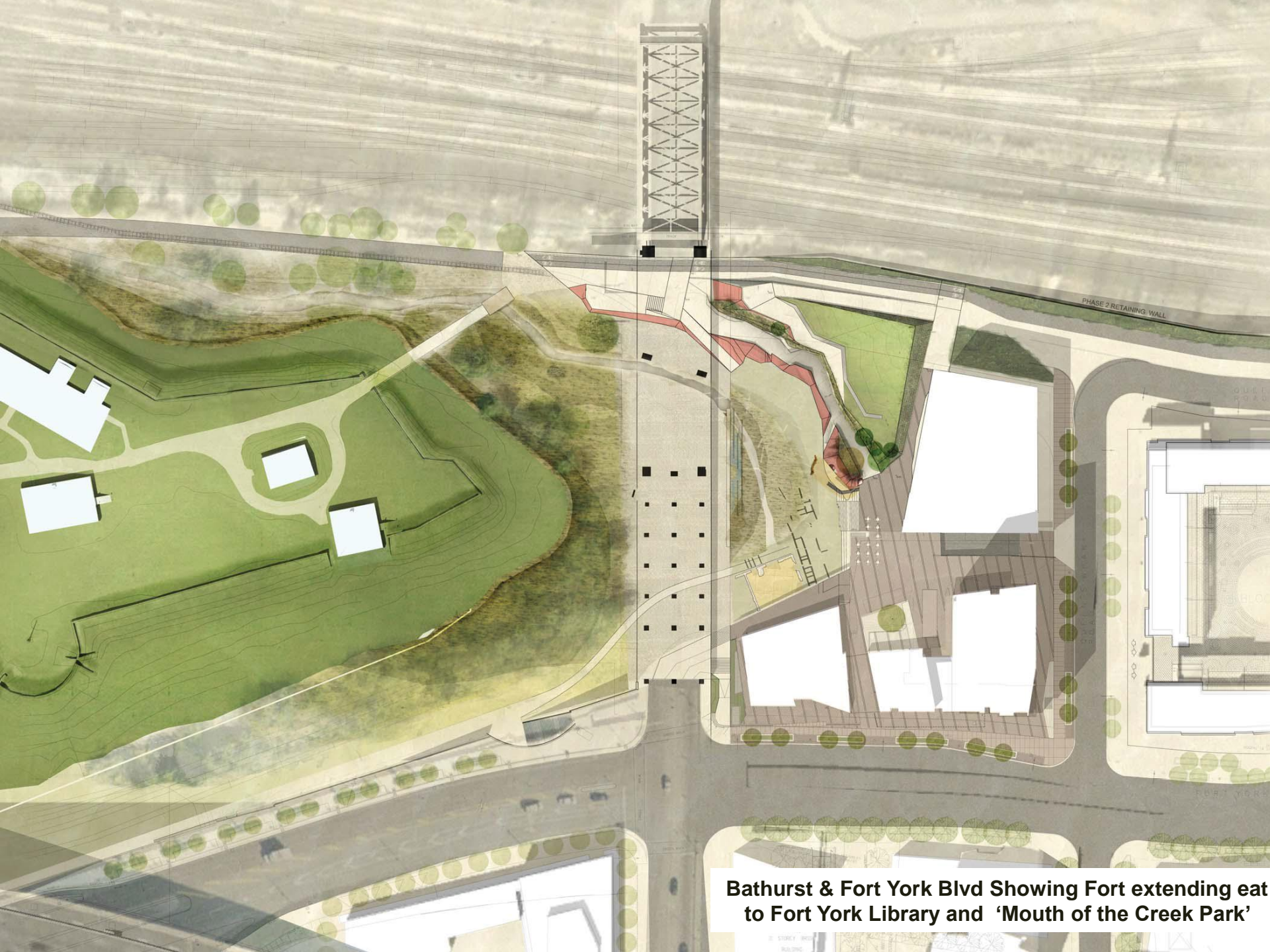

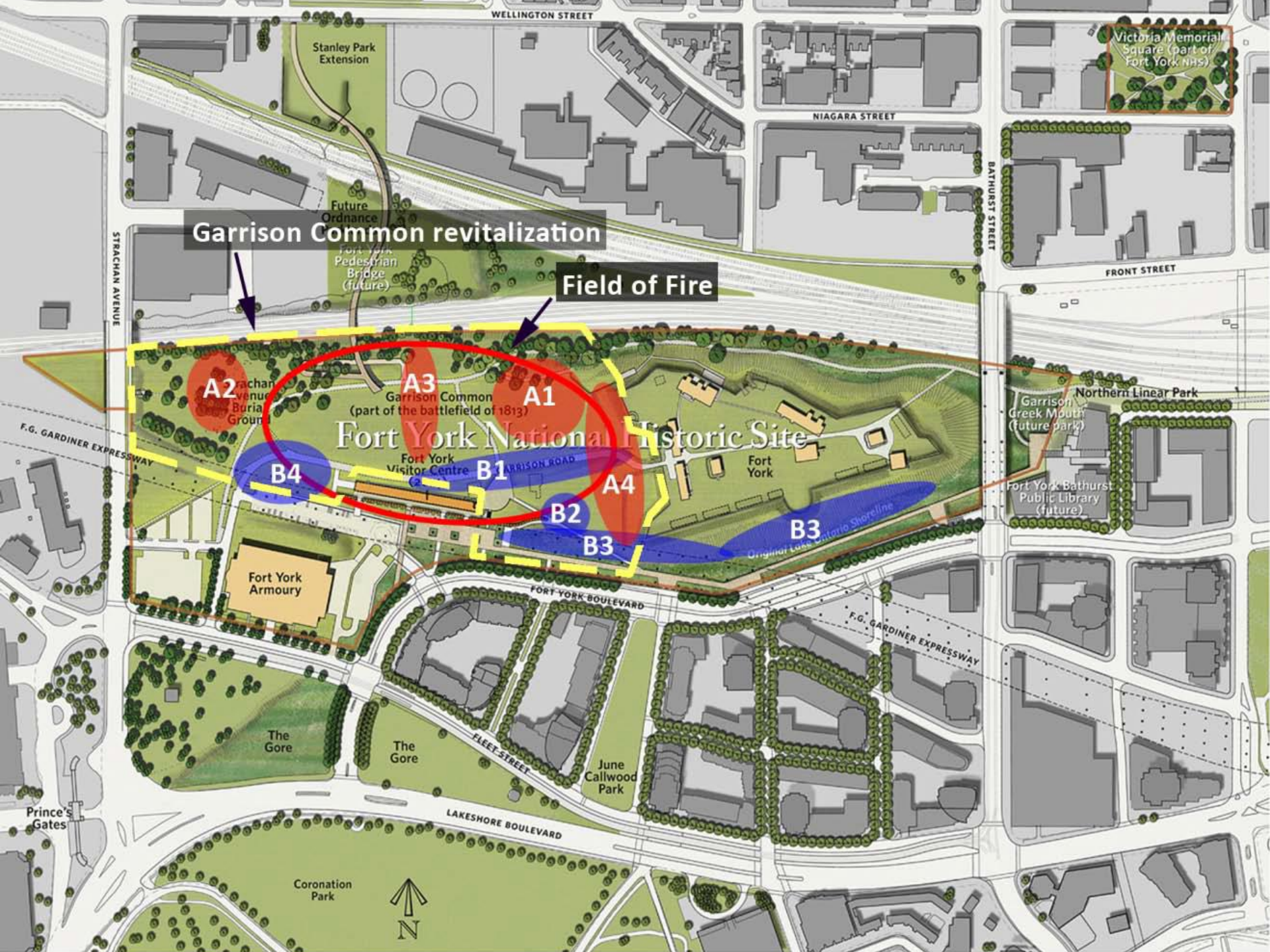
