SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

The purpose of this report is to obtain approval to rescind a portion of the existing "No Standing Anytime" prohibition on the east side of Osler Street that exists from Lindner Street to a point 34.6 metres further south.

This proposed amendment on the east side of the road will allow additional vehicles to park on the east side of the street while maintaining visibility at the intersection of Osler Street and Lindner Street.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services recommends that Etobicoke York Community Council approve:

1. Rescinding the “No Standing Anytime” regulation on the east side of Osler Street, from Lindner Street to a point 34.6 metres south thereof.
2. Enacting a "No Standing Anytime" regulation on the east side of Osler Street, from Lindner Street to a point 9 metres further south.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

Transportation Services staff received a request from the area Councillor, on behalf of area residents, to amend the existing "No Standing Anytime" prohibition on Osler Street, from Lindner Street and a point 34.6 metres further south, to "No Standing Anytime" from Lindner Street to a point 9 metres further south. This would allow additional on street parking for residents (subject to the City wide 3-hour maximum) while maintaining visibility of the intersection of Osler Street and Lindner Street/Pelham Park Gardens. A map of the area is Attachment 1.

COMMENTS

Osler Street is a two-way local road with an 8.5 metre pavement width with sidewalks on both sides of the street. The legal speed limit is 30 km/h accompanied by speed humps. Pelham Park Gardens is a driveway opposite Lindner Street that provides access to the housing complex on the east side of the road.

Parking is currently prohibited at anytime on the west side of the road between Davenport Road and Cariboo Avenue. Parking is also prohibited on the west side of the street between Cariboo Avenue to Dupont Street, anytime, except each Thursday, April 1 to November 30, inclusive and on the east side, each Thursday, April 1 to November 30, inclusive. Parking is allowed up to periods of three-hours on the east side of Osler Street from Davenport Road to Lindner Street and on the east side between a point 34.6 metres south of Lindner Street and Cariboo Avenue.

The proposed amendment to the existing "No Standing Anytime" regulation on the east side of Osler Street from Lindner Street to a point 9 metres south of Lindner Street will allow additional parking for residents of Osler Street while maintaining visibility at the intersection of Osler Street and Lindner Street.
