The Mimico Residents Association (MRA) has been following the issue of ML Ready Mix concrete batching facility located on two sites on Judson Street (#'s 29 and 145) and its effects on the immediate community for the last year.

The major concern of the MRA is that this business continues to disregard City policies, by-laws and permits. The City allowed this facility to set up an operation without any regard for the residents that live 50 feet from this operation. The company now wants an exemption for a fence they have already been asked to remove.
