NEW BUSINESS: Request consideration of proposed names of laneways in Seaton Village, bounded by Dupont Street, Bathurst Street, Bloor Street West and Christie Street

The Harbord Village Residents Association has requested the naming of 20 public lanes in the area bounded by Christie Street to the West, Dupont Street to the north, Bathurst Street to the East, and Bloor Street to the South. Four of the lanes are being named at this time, with the remaining lane names to be considered in future reports.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1) That Toronto East York Community Council:

Request the Manager, Land and Property Surveys to investigate and report to Toronto East York Community Council on the suitability of naming the public lanes in the block bounded by Dupont Street, Bathurst Street, Bloor Street West and Christie Street as "Oscar Ryan Lane", "Belmira Fumo Lane", Mission House Lane", "Hartstone Lane", "John McIntosh Lane", "Shady Lane", "Karma Lane", "Old Crookshank's Lane", "Sunnyview Lane", "Deborah Brown Lane", "Epworth Manse Lane", "Col. David Shank Lane", "Patrick McGregor Lane", "Ken Lai Lane", "Crestfallen Lane" and "Perly Lane".
