


Overview

2014 Operating Budget Highlights

- Base budget pressures of \$2.0k due to net impact of the following:
 - \$5.3k reversal of one-time 2013 budget reduction
 - \$2.3k for progression pay increase
 - \$4.5k in COLA and economic factor adjustments
 - \$10.1k reduction related to budget to actual salary adjustment

2014 Operating Budget Highlights

- One-time budget reduction of \$2.0k in non-payroll to flat-line the 2014 base budget to 2013 budget level
- After budget reduction, the Office will only have \$21.1k in non-payroll budget:
 - Of this non-payroll budget, \$4.2k or 20% is corporate allocation for Insurance Reserve
 - Only \$16.9k is available for non-payroll spending
- Limited budgetary provisions for investigation costs

2014 Operating Budget Highlights

- Enhancement request of \$36.7k
 - This in accordance to Council direction adopting the Integrity Commissioner's recommendation in her Annual Report for a full-time Integrity Commissioner for the next term.
 - Partial year impact in 2014 of converting the Integrity Commissioner from part-time to full-time beginning September 6, 2014. Annualisation impact in 2015 of \$76.4k.
- 2014 budget request of \$299.1k is 0.003% of the Total City Budget request of \$9.6 billion
