

## **Schools-First Capital Implementation Update**

### **SUMMARY**

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This report responds to Community Development and Recreation Committee's request for information on the implementation of the Provincial Schools-First Child Care Capital Retrofit Policy. This policy provides capital funding to school boards to retrofit existing child care space and non-instructional space, so that it can be used for child care for younger children.

As requested by the Committee, the report contains the initial ranked list that was prepared by City staff for consideration by the boards of education. The report also describes the two-stage process for determining capital investments in child care in schools under this policy. The list ranks every school-based child care centre in the City, based on principles of the City's Child Care Service Plan which prioritizes areas of high need that are underserved. The report also identifies additional factors that will impact the feasibility of space conversions in schools.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

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The General Manager, Children's Services, recommends that:

- 1) City Council receive this report for information.

## **Financial Impact**

Capital funding available through the Schools-First Child Care Capital Retrofit Policy is allocated by the Province directly to school boards, with no financial impact to the City.

The Deputy City Manager and Chief Financial Officer has reviewed this report and agrees with the financial impact information.

## **DECISION HISTORY**

At its meeting of February 2013, City Council authorized the General Manager, Children's Services, to endorse joint Consolidated Municipal Service Manager-school board plans for the investment of capital funding allocated to boards of education under the policy and requested that she work with the Ministry of Education to develop appropriate and achievable space conversion targets for Toronto under the Schools-First Child Care Capital Retrofit Policy.

At its meeting of October 28, 2013, the Community Development and Recreation Committee requested the General Manager, Children's Services to report to the January 21, 2014 meeting of the Community Development and Recreation Committee with a summary of the funding allocations and spaces created to date for the Schools First Capital Retrofit policy, and include in the report the City-recommended priority list for school boards for capital allocations under this policy. This list was provided as a first step in the evaluation process and was intended to facilitate discussions between the City and boards of education.

## **ISSUE BACKGROUND**

On July 10, 2012, the Ministry of Education announced a Schools-First Child Care Capital Retrofit Policy that provides \$113 million over three years to school boards to support child care programs located in schools across Ontario. The Toronto District School Board's (TDSB) full allocation is \$14.4 million while the Toronto Catholic District School Board (TCDSB) has been allocated \$3.6 million over the three years. The purpose of this funding is to stabilize the child care system by taking vacant school-based licensed child care spaces that have been created by the enrolment of four and five year olds in Full-Day Kindergarten (FDK), and converting them to spaces that can be licensed for younger children. School boards also have the option of converting non-instructional space to meet the needs of younger children. In either case, the repurposed space is to support child care operators currently providing care within a school. Where schools have significant vacant space and no existing child care operator, approval may be given to move child care from the community to a school without expanding the licensed capacity.

These funds cannot be used for major capital projects that would increase the footprint of the school. This policy is part of the overall transition to a child care system that focuses on younger children as four and five year olds enrol in FDK.

While the capital funds are administered by the school boards, Children's Services has been working closely with boards to plan how these limited resources are invested. School boards receive allocations from the province annually, while space conversion plans can be submitted continuously over the course of the three years. Children's Services has previously reported that under school boards' first submissions, plans were made to add 40 spaces in TDSB schools, 75 in TCDSB schools and 140 spaces in French language schools in Toronto. Initial plans focused on areas where there was little construction required. These plans continue to be updated, with the next submission from the boards to the Province expected in February.

## **COMMENTS**

When the Schools-First Child Care Capital Retrofit Policy was launched, Children's Services raised concerns with the Ministry with respect to how space development targets were established. In a report submitted to the January 2013 Community Development and Recreation Committee, the Division reported that: "Targets assume that there is sufficient physical capacity available in schools and that there is a demand for child care for younger children in every school. These assumptions do not reflect the reality in Toronto, nor do they reflect the City's role as service system manager or the existing Child Care Service Plan. Ideally, space conversion targets would have been established by CMSMs (Consolidated Municipal Service Managers) and based on local knowledge and planning."

As reported to Community Development and Recreation Committee in June 2013, out of 268 analyzed schools in the two English-speaking boards, only 106, or 40%, had space available to retrofit while 162, or 60%, did not and would require additional space in the school if changes were to be made. As such, opportunities to invest under the policy are limited.

On November 30, 2013, the Ministry of Education issued a memo to child care service managers containing the 2013-14 allocations and policy updates. The memo recognized that concerns had been raised regarding the ability to achieve provincially-set space conversion targets. The key policy in the memo provided flexibility to school boards and CMSMs, through a 75 per cent space conversion target threshold. The threshold means that school boards that achieve at least 75 per cent of their space conversion target will keep their entire allocation, while boards that achieve less than 75 per cent of their target will have their allocation reduced proportionately by the Ministry of Education. In Toronto, the lack of existing space in schools and the policy's requirement that schools not be expanded, have resulted in difficulties in meeting the targets. Furthermore, construction costs vary depending on the state of the existing school, making it difficult for the boards to determine how much space can be retrofitted with available resources.

## **Planning**

Planning spaces for capital investment is a two-stage process.

In Stage 1, the City worked with school boards to develop rankings to prioritize potential capital allocations in accordance with the Children's Services Service Plan principles and criteria similar to those used to allocate Best Start resources. As service system manager for child care, the priority for Children's Services has been to increase child care subsidies in areas of greatest need and to increase space in areas that have a significant lack of licensed child care space. These priorities are reflected in the criteria used to develop the initial lists contained in Appendix A and B of this report. Development of these lists considered the characteristics of the child care centre, census tract, and ward. The ranking exercise strategically prioritized locations where current and projected access to infant and toddler spaces is low, and where a high number of families rely on fee subsidy to be able to afford child care.

Stage 2 planning considered other factors, including the availability of space in schools. Upon submission to school boards, the ranked lists were further reviewed to determine if each school had the necessary space or if additional non-instructional space would be required and available. Regardless of a centre's rank, the feasibility of providing capital funding will be impacted by additional factors, including the amount and suitability of space available, the willingness of the operator to reconfigure, the availability of fee subsidies (which can limit the ability for spaces to be filled in some areas of the city), or whether the school is undergoing an Accommodation Review Committee (ARC) process. While the City's original list will guide the order in which centres are approached for funding, centres must have appropriate space available for the reconfiguration, and the operator must be interested in altering their service to serve younger children. As a result, centres appearing lower on the City's initial list may receive funding.

Through this process, to date the TDSB has planned to create 65 spaces at an estimated cost of \$468,000 and the TCDSB has planned the creation of 170 spaces at an estimated cost of \$1,425,000. For both boards, the first phase of site approvals considered the City's list and prioritized projects requiring limited construction in order to meet the tight timeline for the first submission to the Province. Construction has not yet been completed at any of the school sites. While future submissions are still being developed, it is expected that the number of spaces created will be significantly greater than in the first submissions.

## **Board Approval Processes**

The TDSB's full allocation is \$14.4 million with a space conversion target of 2432 spaces. TDSB trustees have been informed of plans.

The TCDSB has been allocated \$3.6 million and given a space conversion target of 608. At the TCDSB, staff report to the Board's Corporate Affairs, Strategic Planning and Property Committee with recommended projects. If there are any modifications to be

made, the report goes back to staff for changes and is brought back to a subsequent meeting. If not, the report is approved at the committee level. The report then goes back to the Board meeting for receipt and approval. These reports are filed as needed.

French school boards have received separate allocations, but these cover a larger area than Toronto and only a portion of the funds and spaces will occur in Toronto.

The City will continue to work with boards to use the ranked list and assess space requirements until all of the Schools-First Child Care Capital Retrofit money is expended or no suitable sites remain. Children's Services continues to work closely with school boards to take advantage of the opportunity to reconfigure school space to provide care for younger children.

## **CONCLUSION**

Schools-First Child Care Capital Retrofit Policy funding is expected to be spent by August 31, 2015. Through its recent memo, the Ministry has also recognized a need for a policy to support new construction child care capital projects, which Children's Services would support as a way of increasing access to licensed child care.
