Subject: Inclusion on the City of Toronto Inventory of Heritage Properties – 51 Panorama Court

Recommendation:

The Toronto Preservation Board recommends to the Etobicoke York Community Council that:

- 1. City Council include the property at 51 Panorama Court, the former Sick Children's Hospital (County Branch) Thistletown, (now the Thistletown Regional Centre for Children and Adolescents) on the City of Toronto Inventory of Heritage Properties, in accordance with the Statement of Significance: Reasons for Listing attached as Revised Attachment No. 3 to the report (February 10, 2014) from the Director, Urban Design, City Planning Division.**
- 2. City Council request the Director, Urban Design, City Planning Division, to identify the potential heritage landscape attributes and landmark uses at 51 Panorama Court and submit an amended listed report to a subsequent meeting of the Toronto Preservation Board.**
