Request to accept financial and in-kind donations for the refurbishment of Pine Point Arena - by Councillor Doug Ford, seconded by Councillor Frances Nunziata

#### Recommendations

Councillor Doug Ford, seconded by Councillor Frances Nunziata, recommends that:

- 1. City Council authorize the General Manager, Parks, Forestry and Recreation to accept the financial donation of \$50,000.00 and in-kind-donations from the Lowe's Community Rink Reno program for the refurbishment of Pine Point Arena.
- 2. City Council authorize the General Manager, Parks, Forestry and Recreation to enter into an agreement with Lowe's Inc. to accept and install donated material and supplies for the refurbishment of Pine Point Arena on terms and conditions satisfactory to the General Manager, Parks, Forestry and Recreation, and in a form and content satisfactory to the City Solicitor.
- 3. City Council adjust the 2014 Operating Budget for Parks, Forestry and Recreation to include the Lowe's donation of \$50,000 offset by increased spending of \$50,000 to refurbish the Pine Point Arena.

### Summary

Authority is being sought to enter into an agreement to accept a \$50,000.00 donation and up to \$35,000 in additional in-kind donations from the Lowe's Community Rink Reno Program in partnership with Hockey Canada to refurbish Pine Point Arena located at 15 Grierson Road.

As part of Lowe's commitment to grassroots hockey in Canada and ensuring that today's youth are playing in safe, accessible, and inspiring facilities, the Lowe's Community Rink Reno Program selects two rinks across Canada each year to refurbish. In 2014, Pine Point Arena was selected as one of those rinks. Lowe's has partnered previously with the City of Toronto in 2012 to refurbish Scarborough Centennial Rink.
