Please accept this as our written notification that the Danforth Business Improvement Area (BIA) will be hosting its 5th Annual Thrill of the Grill bbq fundraiser on Saturday, July 19, 2014 from noon to 4pm. This event is raising funds for kidney cancer research at Sunnybrook's Odette Cancer Centre.

The Danforth BIA will be working with the City of Toronto Street Events Department to secure a road closure for this event. Danforth Avenue will be closed to traffic from Jackman Avenue to Broadview Avenue.

As part of this year's event, the BIA will be organizing beer/wine sampling areas within the road closure. The total area is approximately 3 sections of 150 feet in length and 30 feet wide each; the area will be tented by Higgins Tent Rentals; and, barricaded by 3 foot high fencing.

I will be applying for a Special Occasion Permit from the LCBO store in The Manulife Centre, Store #528; and, am requesting that this event be declared an Event of Municipal Significance.
