At its meeting on Wednesday, May 27, 2015 the TTC Board considered the attached report entitled "Auditor General's Report – Continuous Controls Monitoring Program – Toronto Transit Commission, 12-Month Review of Employees Overtime and Related Expenses, 2014".

The Board adopted the recommendation in the staff report, as follows:
